Making Missions Possible at Home



I can't believe it! We are entering our fourth month of our current campaign, a.k.a., **Missions Possible**. We have said all along that this effort by F2W is all about partnering those who have with those who

have not.

In our first two months, April and May, F2W had a minimum of one, week long, out-of-town mission trip per month. And this month almost three entire weeks will be spent working overseas with the people of Masinloc, Philippines. Therefore, to maintain our 50/50 home and away balance, F2W spent the entire month of June focusing its efforts on our hometown of Anderson, SC. And month three was a busy month to say the least.

One of F2W's projects was to build a deck railing for an elderly widow. Ms. Smith recently fell off her porch and injured her knee because of the lack of a railing. Unable to afford the materials, F2W partnered with Anderson Interfaith Ministries to build Ms. Smith a beautiful railing for her front porch and stairs.



Another local project conducted was returning to Morningside Park. F2W has developed a partnership with the community of Morningside and continues to help them beautify their park. Currently F2W and its great volunteers have cleared and cleaned over 90% of the park. Through this partnership the city and county governments are taking an interest and are now helping maintain this beautiful park.

One of the highlights for me this past month was working with a small church here in Anderson. I had the opportu-

nity to speak at one of their Wednesday night services. I spoke on missions and challenged the audience to make missions possible by making missions personal. That we are each called to be missionaries.

Later in the month I was able to take some of the church's youth out for a Fun Day on Lake Hartwell. The kids spent the day swimming and trying



to hold on to an inner tube for dear life! It was a great day of fun and fellowship with some awesome kids that do not always have the same opportunities as other youth that attend large churches.

It has been a busy, but awesome month for F2W working here in Anderson, SC. God is using this ministry, its supporters, and its volunteers to accomplish some truly great things. And with more local and away projects scheduled I can't wait to see what God is going to do next!

Many of you have asked how you can help with our *Missions Possible* campaign. Here are three specific

missions you can get involved with.

Operation Rolling Response: F2W is ready to launch its *Mobile Response Unit* (MRU). To properly equip the trailer, we are currently in need of push lawnmowers, string trimmer, blower, shovels, rakes, clippers, miter saw, skill saws, corded drills, sockets, wrenches, screw drivers and other misc. hand tools.

Operation Home Again: F2W has adopted one family in the hurricane ravaged town of Bay St Louis. After almost two years Jeff and his family, while close to moving into their new home, are still living in a FEMA camper trailer. As F2W continues to send teams to help Jeff, we are currently requesting designated monetary donations for this specific rebuild effort.

Operation Overseas: As F2W heads back to the Philippines this month to work with a small Christian school, we are currently requesting monetary donations for the construction of their school building & trip costs, and for school supplies & aids for the children and teachers.
